

## Aster novae-angliae



**Family:** Asteraceae    **Common Name:** New England Aster

- Height: 3-6'
- Spread: 2-3'
- Light requirements: Full sun
- Soil: moist, rich, well drained
- Flower: Showy, deep pink, purple
- Bloom Time: August-October
- Growth: Herbaceous perennial
- Native Origin: Missouri
- Interesting Fact: NE Aster attracts butterflies, birds, bees and other pollinators and also tolerates clay soils.
